Facts found:	<p>1- FS submitted Request number 59 to the event website on April 3rd.</p> <p>2- The request includes the following two sentences: 'It seems to me that this case has been thrown out based on a technicality as opposed to what is right and fair for the sailors. There is a serious abuse of power taking place in order to cover up a race officers mistake.'</p> <p>3- The request was published on the website at April 3rd, 18:18.</p> <p>4- After founding out that the request was published online open to public, FS did not request the Organizing Authority to remove it.</p> <p>5- On April 4th noon time, FS sent an email to the International Jury through OA where he apologized for his behaviour.</p> <p>6- FS also apologized to the Int. Jury during the hearing.</p>
Conclusion:	By stating the two sentences above, FS committed a breach of good manners and a breach of good sportsmanship. Furthermore, by posting these statements on an open and public website, he also brought the sport into disrepute.
